**FOR THOSE ARRESTED FOR DRINKING AND DRIVING,
FIRST OFFENSE**

Alcohol Highway Safety Education is a prevention/education program for adults, age 18 or above, facing their very first arrest for drinking and driving. The participant's BAC must be .15 or lower. In this program, individuals will learn basic information about alcohol, drinking and driving, and how to decrease the risk of drinking and driving in the future.

WHEN: SAT. 9 a.m. - 3 P.M.

This program is offered every other month, or more frequently if there is a need. At the end of the day participants will receive a certificate of completion.
