

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2006-01

COURT TO SCHOOL PROGRAM

The purpose of this order is to conduct a court session at a local high school in Jackson County. The Court has developed a judicial education program designed for high school students. The name of the program is "Court to School Program." The Court and Vandercook Lake High School, located in Jackson County, have agreed to form an educational partnership based upon the program. A component of the program requires students to attend a session of court.

IT IS ORDERED: The Honorable R.D. Mazur will conduct a session of court on February 2, 2006 at Vandercook Lake High School, located in Jackson County. The session will commence at 9:30 a.m. The afternoon session of court will be held at the Jackson County Courthouse.

Parties must consent to having their cases heard at Vandercook Lake High School.

The Great Seal of the State of Michigan and the flags of the United States of America and the State of Michigan will be prominently displayed during the court session.

The court will issue a press release advising that cases scheduled before the Honorable R. Darryl Mazur between 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on February 2, 2006 will be heard at Vandercook Lake High School.
